The final day of the event provided informative sessions beginning with a panel discussion consisting of Tom Sulek/ Star Stainless Screw, Anthony Crawl/Birmingham Fastener, and Matt Dyess/Nucor Fastener. Discussions revolved around the challenges of business including overseas issues, pricing, inventory issues, changes

in procedures since 2020, supply chain challenges, hiring issues, and opportunities. Business has been challenging but the challenges have also come with rewards.

Following the panel discussion Scott Brindisi, VP Client Solutions for Unique Logistics International addressed the group. He began by apologizing he had no good news. Logistics have been a challenge for quite some time; however, past circumstances have never caused issues like COVID has. Between flights stopping during COVID, containers taking much longer to get back overseas, container losses, health related issues, Chinese New Year, and the Suez Canal shut down logistics have been a nightmare. Pricing and lead time have increased beyond any expectations. Unfortunately the logistics industry does not expect to see things back to normal for the rest of this year.

Adrienne Slack, VP and Regional Executive at the New Orleans Branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta also addressed SEFA members. Adrienne spoke of the challenges of businesses finding employees. While we have had in a very low inflation rate, inflation is expected to increase to above 2%. Consumer prices are escalating as the shortage of products continues. This trend has also greatly affected the real estate market.

Unemployment benefits have allowed some of the work force to remain unemployed longer than normal. Unemployment rates had been dropping since 2017 until COVID surfaced in mid March 2020. Jobs are plentiful; those willing to work are limited. Wage wars have caused those working to move from company to company. Personal consumption dropped dramatically in 2020 but is now on the rise. Government has offered aid to companies and individuals but it may have to stop before we see the work force go back to normal. While in town, Adrienne had the opportunity to speak with many local businesses as well as attendees regarding our industry to discuss the various factors affecting the shortage of employees for businesses.

There is no doubt the economy has been erratic since Mid March 2020. The public has the option to stay up to date with the EconomyNow app providing current info on economic issues.

The meeting closed out with a drawing for a complimentary (sponsored by SEFA) Certified Fastener Specialist Class conducted by Fastener Training Week. Matt Dyess of Nucor Fasteners was the recipient of this class.
