#### Nucor Says Acquisition Of Shelbyville Facility Set To Boost Its Fastener Division

Nucor Corporation (NUE), a producer of steel and related products, on Wednesday said it is expanding its Nucor Fastener division with the acquisition of a coil processing facility in Shelbyville, Indiana.

The proposed site includes an automated clean and coat line, 2 STC furnaces and wire drawing capabilities. In addition to coil processing, the company will also be expanding its fastener manufacturing capabilities by installing bolt making equipment at the Shelbyville facility, the North California-headquartered company said.

This new operation is expected to employ approximately 33 team members at the outset with the potential to double those jobs as it reaches full capacity.

Along with recently announced upgrades at the Nebraska engineered bar mill, this new facility is expected to allow Nucor to better service the automotive cold heading quality (CHQ) market and provide customers with the highest quality products.

The Shelbyville facility will also allow the Nucor Engineered Bar group to offer processed coil with superior surface quality for the most demanding automotive CHQ applications, the metal manufacturer added.

"Adding bolt making capability to the Shelbyville facility will help expand our offerings to the automotive, heavy truck, industrial/ MRO and structural fastener markets. Nucor Fastener is already a leader in steel fasteners and this expansion will further enhance that position," said Joey Loosle, General Manager of Nucor Fastener.

# The Logistics and Economic Challenges Continue

On December 16th truckstop.com provided a webinar for AEA (American Education Alliance) members updating attendees on the current and expected trucking logistic challenges. Speakers were were Brent Hutto,Truckstop.com Chief Relationship Officer and Noel Perry, Principle at Transport Futures. May and June were the peak months in trucking being 100% above normal on what needed to be moved. The U.S. is the largest freight marketplace as the U.S. is the largest consumer. Mileage costs in the past were \$2.05, now the are up to \$2.88.

It will take a while to see normalcy. There are always causes for change and the most recent affects have been 2014-Regulations, 2017-18-Economy (creating highest rates in 38 years) and 2020-Pandemic (creating highest rates in 40 years). Having three major influences in six years is not the norm.

We are not in an unusual peak of economic activity, but the surge was unusual. The shortage of drivers is due to our economy surge. It is difficult to find drivers as many quit after the first 30 days. Sleeping in a truck and eating at trucks tops does not appeal to most. There just are not enough drives for the economic surge to make the system fluid. It is not just a driver shortage but also location shortage. Trucks are often not in location needed.

Automation in freight markets is forcing changes. Automation is expensive and adoption is slow.

After the pandemic, goods and investments recovered much quicker than services. People found themselves with more income to spend as they were not traveling, going out to eat, or utilizing other services. The consumption of goods is much higher than services. While the press reports the market is getting worse, it is slowly improving.

Fuel costs are up since demand in the world is up. Fuel surcharges is where to tack on extra charges to your customer as the costs are still fluctuating. This surcharge has become more common due to the challenge of making up costs. It is expected overall pricing of product will be back to normal by the end of 2022.

COVID statistics are watched to assist with expectations of economic situations. Also watch inflation. The economy depends on low interest rates. When rates begin to rise there is concern of a recession

There are expectations that the truckload volume will not be back to normal until 2025. This prediction is barring another economic disaster.
