

Jim served as president in 1976, Robbie served in 1984, Mickey served in 1993, and Brian served in 2001 so quite a few years of interesting memories and knowledge was shared.

Keynote speaker Derrick Brooks closed out the event. Derrick Brooks was born and raised in Pensacola, FL. He grew up with many challenges yet reached past all his struggles and became a first-round NFL draft pick by the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 1995. This began his 14-year, hall of fame career. He was inducted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame in February 2014 and the Capital One Academic All America Hall of Fame in August 2014. As driven as Derrick Brooks was to build his career, he poured himself into his family and community. Legacy is at the heart of his drive. He recognizes that life itself is a team game, the ultimate team game. And this is why his community efforts are so imperative to him.

Derrick emphasized the importance of TEAM-together everybody achieves more. This is important not only in sports but in life. When you fall short, get back up. One of the most inspiring memories of coaches he has is the one who told them they need to live by three F's-faith, family, and football-in that order. He learned to serve the community through football which led him to start foundations of his own to assist others. His secret to a good transition from football to retirement was doing things the opposite-schedule things different than during football. You are a person transitioning not a number. A thought-provoking closing remark was if attitude is contagious-is yours worth getting?

The conference provided numerous networking opportunities essential for business growth. The success of SEFA events relies heavily on the support of its members and guests. A heartfelt thank you to everyone who contributed to the success of the SEFA Spring Conference 2025 making the 50th anniversary a formidable cause to celebrate.




